## 2<sup>nd</sup> Base Double Play Pivot Drill

For this drill we will simulate a 5-4-3 double play. For younger kids this could be a 6-4-3 double play.

Have a coach hit or throw a ground ball hit to the  $3^{rd}$  baseman... $3^{rd}$  baseman to make good throw to  $2^{nd}$  base (this is also a good time to use "Follow the Throw Drill" for the  $3^{rd}$  baseman).... $2^{nd}$  baseman to work on foot work around bag and pivot to  $1^{st}$  base.

The #1 job of the  $2^{nd}$  baseman when the ball is hit to the  $3^{rd}$  baseman with a man on  $1^{st}$  base is to get to the bag a quickly as possible. Show a big target for the  $3^{rd}$  baseman or SS to hit....have the kids set up on the bag square to the  $3^{rd}$  baseman or SS...left foot on the bag...where ever the throw may go....your right foot will go to the ball...secure the catch...make a good throw to  $1^{st}$  base

For drill purposes have the  $2^{nd}$  baseman a little closer to the bag than normal playing depth.
